- Grant allocation will range from a minimum of £3,000 based on a £7,500 spend up to a maximum grant of £12,000 based on a £30,000 spend.
- Applicants must attend a 'Farming for the Future' roadshow and business turnover must not exceed £1million
- Applicants must attend a 'Farming for the Future' roadshow with a decision made on successful applications on 2 August
- 500 applicants will be accepted for the first application window
- First application window opens 2 May until 30 June 2017
- the four year period in one of the 10 application windows
- Applicants only get one opportunity to apply for funding over windows for grant applications over the next four years as part of a £40 million allocation of grant funding available to farmers.

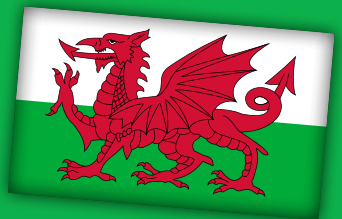
